# **Story**

The demon world's feast has begun! You hear people shouting "VAMOS! VAMOS!" Today is VAMOS day, so let's have fun without getting too drunk.

X VAMOS means "Let's go!" in Portuguese.

In the demon world, "VAMOS" is used to encourage people to drink during the feast. "Dia" means day in Portuguese. So, VAMOS dia = Let's Go Day.

### Contents

#### 36 cards total

Blue 1-9 (9 cards) Negative Skull Cards

Yellow 10-20 (11 cards) Positive Star Cards

Red 21-30 (10 cards)
Positive Star Cards

Purple 31-36 (6 cards) Negative Skull Cards

#### **VAMOS Cards**

5 (Blue),15 (Yellow), 25 (Red) When a VAMOS card is played and after the winner is decided, all players play another card face-down. See the <u>VAMOS Cards</u> section for full details.

# **Summary**

Play must-follow tricks over and over, competing for the total points from Stars on the cards you collect (+1 point for each Star and -1 point for each Skull). The winner of a trick with a VAMOS Card must take an additional card to score from each player. A player's final score will total all their scores from each round. The number of rounds will equal the number of players.

### <u>Setup</u>

Adjust the 36-card deck to suit the number of players.

- **3 players:** Randomly remove 9 cards and deal 9 cards to each player
- 4 players: Use all the cards and deal 9 cards to each player
- 5 players: Randomly remove 1 card and deal 7 cards to each player

Removed cards will not be used during that round. At the end of each round, shuffle all the cards together (including any removed cards), and then remove cards again based on the number of players.

You'll need to keep score, so please prepare pencil and paper or tokens.

# How to Play

The person who recently drank something is the first lead player.

The lead player plays one card of their choice from their hand face-up on the table in front of them.

Subsequent players also take turns playing one face-up card at a time, clockwise. At this time, if you have a card of the color that the dealer played, you must play it. If not, play any card of your choice.

After each player has played one card, determine who won the trick.

- 1. Cards of a different color than the lead player's card cannot win the trick.
- 2. The highest-numbered card matching the color of the lead player's card wins.

The winner receives the lowest-numbered card played that trick and places it in a pile in front of themself. They will score this card at the end of the round. The rest of the played cards are discarded. (This process changes if a VAMOS Card is played, as explained in the <u>VAMOS Cards</u> section.)

If players have any cards left in their hands, then the player who won the trick is the next lead player. When all cards in your hands are gone, the round ends. Proceed to Round Scoring.

At the beginning of a new round, the player to the left of the player who started the previous round will be the first lead. When you reach the end of a round and every player has been the first lead player once, the game ends, and players proceed to <u>Final Scoring</u>.

# **VAMOS Cards**

The cards with the numbers 5 (Blue), 15 (Yellow), and 25 (Red) are VAMOS Cards.

The player who played the VAMOS card should call out "VAMOS! VAMOS!" The others should also shout "VAMOS! VAMOS!" Once everyone has played a card, determine who wins the trick. All players then choose one card from their hand and turn it face-down on the table and say "Dear!"

The winner of a trick with a VAMOS Card should probably play their highest-scoring card face-down, as other players will probably play cards face-down with negative points.

The winner of the trick with the VAMOS Card takes all the face-down cards and puts them in a pile in front of themself. All cards played face-up in the current trick are discarded.

Do not look at any collected face-down cards until they are scored at the end of the round.

- **Q.** What if a VAMOS Card is played in the final trick (when no one has cards left in their hands)?
- **A.** The VAMOS Card has no effect. The winner will take the lowest-numbered card.
- **Q.** What if two VAMOS Cards are played in the same trick?
- **A.** Proceed as if one VAMOS Card was played. Each player will still play one card face-down.

# **Round Scoring**

Scoring takes place at the end of each round.

Turn over any face-down score cards. Each player adds the number of Stars and subtracts the number of Skulls on any cards they collected. The total is their score for that round.

At the end of each round, each player adds their score from that round to their total score.

## Final Scoring and Winner

The player with the highest total score at the end of the final round will be the King of Heavy Drinkers.

Sometimes everyone will have negative points. In that case, the player with the fewest negative points will be the King of Heavy Drinkers!
